2017 NEHA Policy Statements

Sale or Distribution of Raw Milk

Recognition of scientific and public health evidence that pasteurization of milk is proven to be a sound method of preventing milk-borne disease.

<u>Uniform and Integrated Food</u> <u>Safety System Adoption</u>

Integration of uniform and current best practices in food safety by state, local, tribal, and territorial government agencies, along with industry food safety professionals.

Model Aquatic Health Code

Adoption of the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention's Model Aquatic Health Code, by state, local, tribal, and territorial government agencies, to ensure public health and safety in aquatic facilities.

<u>Climate Change</u> | Climate change is affecting environmental health—the quality of air, food, and water in the communities where we live, work, and play.

REPORT FROM REGION 4 CONFERENCE

In September Minnesota hosted a 3 day <u>FDA Central Region Retail Food</u> <u>Protection Seminar & NEHA Region 4 Biennial Educational Conference</u>. Here are some fun statistics: 15 months of planning, 4 committees, 30 committee members, 6 themed educational tracks composed of 40 sessions with 66 speakers, 66 swag bags, 370 attendees, 22 exhibitors, 11 sponsors, 8 poster presenters, 5 networking events, 1 podcast, 1 silent auction, and 1 raffle. Region 4 has been conducting these conferences every two years since the 1990's and Nebraska will host in 2019.
